

SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST FOR 2009-2010

The following are the lists of school supplies that students must purchase for the fall of 2009. Some supplies will certainly need to be replenished by you during the school year as they run out and teachers may request additional items as the year progresses.

KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST

There is no school pack for kindergarten students. All of their general school supplies will be provided by their teachers.

Should be purchased or supplied separately by parents and students:

- book bag for transporting projects and lunches
- 1 beach towel for rest
- 1 drawstring or plastic zippered bag (like the type baby quilts or sheet sets come in) to store the rest mat
- clear plastic shoe box size container with a complete change of clothing to store in school
- Boys should have their own special kippah(the large ones that don't need clips are best)
These can be purchased at Israel Book Store or Kolbo in Brookline or at your synagogue gift shop.
- extra kippot (one will be provided in September by the school)
- good hair clips for kippot (not bobby pins)
- 1 package of fat markers any color combination
- 1 package of thin markers any color combination
- 1 box of fat crayons

GRADE ONE SUPPLY LIST

- 1 blank spiral bound sketch book with a minimum of 100 pages, approximately 9" x 12"
- 2 packages of 16 Crayola crayons
- 1 package of 12 Crayola colored pencils
- 1 package (1 doz) of #2 pencils
- 1 pencil box (hard container) 2 ¼ x 5 ¼ x 8 ¼
- 1 package of glue sticks (at least 5)
